Re: GCSE PE Video Evidence



Schools and colleges are required to provide audio-visual evidence of student performances in all activities undertaken outside their direct supervision and/or that cannot be replicated at a live moderation visit. These supporting videos are required evidence for the GCSE to prove the level and grade the performer is playing at. Therefore, could you please help support the PE department, with their non-exam assessment, by providing video evidence of your child in a sporting activity, if they play at club standard outside of school.

What evidence is required

For football, rugby and netball: a 30-minute video of them performing. This must be a continuous video, in a full sided competitive match with no breaks in play. To ensure the authenticity of the performance, the student's face must be clearly visible at the start of the recording. If the activity involves multiple competitors, e.g. team games, the student must stipulate how they can be identified on the recording, e.g. by a coloured bib or a shirt number. This ensures that the teacher can be confident the performance on the recording is authentic and is by the student.

For team sports, such as cricket, students should perform in a fully competitive cricket match (11 versus 11), demonstrating the skills appropriate to their chosen positions. Performers must choose two of the following roles: batting, bowling, fielding/wicket keeper. The video should be continuous and show several overs.

For individual sports, like horse riding, gymnastics and boxing students have been provided with a list of criteria, which needs to be videoed. The assessment criteria has also been uploaded onto Google Classroom for students to access.

The video evidence needs to be completed and handed in to Miss Goldsworthy by Friday 19th December. If you are unable to meet this deadline or have any further questions, please get in touch.
